HEALTH & SAFETY:

Always take great care when operating powered machinery such as mowers and strimmers. Wear appropriate safety protection, including eye goggles, ear defenders, sturdy gloves and robust footwear. Strimmers in particular can kick up lots of debris, so a face visor is recommended. Always read and follow the manufacturer's safety and operating instructions.

VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT:

Volunteers will be provided with supervision at all times.

Volunteers are covered by the club insurance policy.

Volunteers will be advised of any risk assessment prior to the commencement of any works.

Volunteers will be provided with relevant PPE and first aid facilities.

Volunteers contribution of time is at their own discretion.

Volunteers shall treat each other with respect and dignity.

Volunteers shall do nothing to bring the club into disrepute.

Volunteers have no contract of employment and therefore do not have the same rights as employees. This is not intended to be a contract between the club and the volunteer.
